HOW TO UPGRADE TO THE NEW BOOTLOADER

The bootloader is the part of the firmware which takes care of upgrading the main firmware. Nome II came with a brand new bootloader, much smarter and much faster, and your Midronome (Nome I) needs to upgrade its bootloader for any future firmware updates.

To do this you will need to:

- 1. Use the "Upgrade Midronome Bootloader Part 1" utility program to load a special firmware
 - (note: this is the "Firmware Updater" tool you may have used before, to upgrade your Midronome)
 - a. Follow the steps and when asked, select the "upgrade-bootloader.midr" file
 - b. when finished, the device will show "UPG" and a green light

This will upgrade the bootloader but also erase the firmware.

- 2. Use the second program, "Upgrade Midronome Bootloader Part 2", to load FW v3.1
 - a. This will use the new bootloader
 - b. When finished your device will be usable again, and ready for future firmware upgrades

Then you may delete all of these programs.

Note for Mac Users:

- It seems the old bootloader does not work with macOS 15.0 (Sequoia).
- If you are on macOS 15 already, **step 1** will probably not work, so we suggest you find either another mac with an older macOS or a Windows machine to perform step 1.
- Step 2 will work on any macOS or Windows, including Sequoia.
